Each week this column highlights a typical "hurt, habit or hang-up" that people might address through their participation in Celebrate Recovery (CR).

*This week the focus is on:*

### Love and Relationship Addiction for Women

*Nature of the Challenge:*

Do you struggle with unhealthy relationships one after another? Do you relate to any of the following?

- \*Lack of nurturing and attention when young
- \*Avoid rejection at all cost
- \*Afraid to trust in a relationship
- \*Mistake intensity for intimacy
- \*Feel isolated, detached from parents and family
- \*Highly manipulative and controlling of others
- \*Intense need to control self, others, and circumstances

*What to do about it:*

We provide a safe place to deal with depression, isolation, lack of trust and the unhealthy use of love and relationships as a means of achieving worth. People addictions are complicated. We learn to eliminate the unhealthy and promote the healthy relationship. Our goal is to foster healthy relationships and eliminate the unhealthy ones. CR offers a path to freedom from this addiction. CR is a Christ-Centered 12 Step Program based on 8 Recovery Principles found in the Beatitudes for anyone with hurts, hang-ups and habits.
