PRAYER FOR MUSLIMS DURING RAMADAN

Over the last forty years, Libya has ascended from among the world's poorest countries to one of Africa's richest. Despite the welcome afforded the Lockerbie terrorist last week, Libya has shown signs of changing direction and rejoining the mainstream global community.

From the perspective of the Libyan government, all Libyan citizens are Muslim. Yet, there are signs of change. A growing spiritual hunger is being detected among the Libyan people. Ramadan began last week (August 21). For thirty days, practicing Muslims fast, pray, give to charity and put more effort into following the teachings of Islam. From dawn to dusk, Muslims are required to abstain from food, drink and other activities. They will also try to overcome emotions such as anger, envy, greed and lust.

Would you join in praying for this country that its citizens may find the Way God disclosed in Jesus Christ. Pray for God to be manifested to them. Pray God will raise up men and women of peace in Libya. Pray that Nations University may be used by Him to teach and extend Harpeth Hills' involvement in Islamic evangelism.
